			<p>1. Minimum of one year of completed academic studies (60ECTS) is required for incoming exchange students.</p> <p>2. In general, we would like incoming exchange students to choose course packages with at least some course(s) that are offered by the Department of Child and Youth Studies. Course placements outside of the Department of Child and Youth Studies cannot be guaranteed but can usually be arranged (especially placements at other Teacher Education Departments).</p> <p>3. We wish for those partner universities that are able to nominate exchange students for both semesters to try to distribute the nominations evenly. (In other words: not to nominate the maximal number students per academic year for the autumn semester and no students for the spring semester - or the other way around). If the partner university is only able to nominate students for one of the semesters (due to differences in semester dates, education structure etc.) this is of course okay. We may be able to accept additional students (especially spring semesters) please check in advance if you would like to nominate additional students.</p> <p>4.
