The institutions agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. Teaching at CEU is conducted exclusively in English and classes are discussion-based. Erasmus students are fully integrated with CEU's degree-seeking students who have demonstrated in their applications proficiency of English. For this reason, we expect from Erasmus applicants a command of the English language comparable to that of our degree students (generally on Level B2-C1 in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). Admission for Erasmus studies at CEU is not automatic. Applicants are asked to submit an online application. Submitted applications are evaluated on the basis of the quality of the application, the applicant's academic strength as well as his/her knowledge of English. It is possible to nominate for Spring Term only, but please keep in mind that this time is reserved for thesis writing and individual consultations. Very few courses are offered, so students might not be able to earn the required amount of credits.
